Hand Harvested  
Made in steel with no oak influences

## Product Information:

The grapes are hand-picked in September, cold alcohol-fermented in stainless tanks. This wine smells of pure summer delight, with an amazingly fruit-flavored profile.

## Wine Tasting:

Close your eyes, waft the glass to your nose, take a deep breath and with a little imagination, you will escape directly into a field of flowers. What makes Sauvignon unique from other white wines are its herbaceous flavors like bell pepper, jalapeño, gooseberry and grass. The primary fruit flavors of Sauvignon de Purcari are lime, green apple, passion fruit and white peach.
