## Vinification:

100% Pinot Grigio  
Hand Harvested  
Made in steel with no oak influences

## Product Information:

The grapes are hand-picked in September, cold alcohol-fermented in stainless tanks.

## Wine Tasting:

The relatively pale colour with green highlights suggests this will be a Pinot Grigio in the Italian mode, but the nose and palate deliver a far more Alsatian experience, full-bodied, almost viscous, with exotic and candied fruit notes and an engagingly savoury note on the finish.
