### Product Information:

Malbec is a French grape variety, nowadays, mainly, grown in Argentina. In 1853, Michel Pouget – a French agronomist, was hired by the Argentine government to select French grape varieties and to acclimatize them in Argentina. Surprisingly, but Malbec variety has adapted very well in all the regions it was planted, moreover, the wines were even better than in the country of origin.

### Wine Tasting:

Malbec de Purcari is a wine with a strong personality that will surprise you - it's an explosion of grace, perfect for edgy combinations and the most surprising olfactory mixtures. Malbec wine has a ruby color, with purple reflections, with subtle shades of blackberries, black currants and violets. The taste is sophisticated, texture is velvety, tannins are soft and silky.
